July 26 , 2026 | SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

What do you treasure the most and how do you keep it from being lost or stolen? In a peasant community the best safe was often the earth. The man in the parable (Matthew 13:44) "went in his joy" to sell everything. Why? Because he found a treasure worth possessing above all else he had. He did not, however, have enough to buy the treasure. Fortunately, he only needed enough to buy the field. In a similar fashion, God offers his kingdom of righteousness, peace, and joy (Romans 14:17) as incomparable treasure at a price we can afford! We can't pay the full price for the life which God gives us; but when we exchange our life for the life which God offers, we receive a treasure beyond compare.



¿Qué es lo que más valoras y cómo evitas que se pierda o te lo roben? En una comunidad campesina, la mejor caja fuerte solía ser la tierra. El hombre de la parábola (Mateo 13:44) «fue lleno de gozo» a venderlo todo. ¿Por qué? Porque había encontrado un tesoro que valía más que cualquier otra cosa que poseyera. Sin embargo, no tenía lo suficiente para comprar el tesoro mismo; afortunadamente, solo necesitaba lo necesario para comprar el campo. De manera similar, Dios nos ofrece su reino de justicia, paz y gozo (Romanos 14:17) como un tesoro incomparable, ¡a un precio que podemos pagar! No podemos pagar el precio total de la vida que Dios nos da; pero, al cambiar nuestra vida por la que Dios ofrece, recibimos un tesoro inigualable.

- ✝ Canonized: May 26, 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI
- ✝ Graduated with doctorates in civil and canon law at age 16
- ✝ National Shrine of St. Alphonsus Liguori is located in Baltimore, MD
- ✝ Gifted musician and composer
- ✝ Was noted for suspending priests who celebrated Mass in less than 15 minutes
- ✝ Sold his episcopal ring to give money to the poor
- ✝ Patron Saint of Rheumatoid Arthritis
- ✝ One of 37 Doctors of the Catholic Church recognized for their significant contribution to theology and Doctrine.
